From the Pastor

“Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, ²looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God..” Hebrews 12:1-2

Will spring come again? New life that casts off the dead of winter will spring forth again (pun intended), though at times we wonder. There is the witness of springs past that helps us have such hope and persevere even in the longest of winters, looking to the goal that lies ahead: spring and new life! But, first there is winter.

With the coming of spring and its new life, as followers of the Christ we look to the coming of Easter again and the new life that is ours in the Risen Lord. This new life brings hope that saves us from the sin and struggles and death that would harm and destroy us. But, first we have Lent. This 40 day period of preparation for Easter is a call to self examination, repentance, and a turning around of our minds and lives back to new life with God, through Christ. As Jesus began his earthly ministry his message was: “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near.” Where Jesus is, there is the reign of God; there is the power to make new hearts and minds and lives that show grace, mercy, forgiveness and service towards others as we have received in Christ.

This Lenten season the theme of our midweek Lenten services will be “Touched by the Master’s Hand.” Neighboring pastors will be sharing in a Lenten “Round Robin,” and will be presenting the witness of biblical characters who experienced new life in their encounter with Jesus. We will hear the stories of **John**: the Beloved Apostle, one of Jesus’ closest disciples; the **Paralytic**, healed after his friends lowered him through a ceiling into a crowded room before the very presence of Jesus; the **Samaritan woman** at Jacob’s well, an outcast who went and brought her whole village back to the well that they too might hear Jesus; **Martha**, a dear friend of Jesus, who with her sister Mary witnessed Jesus raise their brother, Lazarus, from the dead; and, **Nicodemus**, a Pharisee who came to Jesus in the dark of night to talk about the kingdom of God, and who would later help bury the crucified Lord. Male and female, rich and poor, friend and stranger, outcast and elite, all longed to know the healing presence of Jesus, the hoped for Messiah. Their stories have been passed on through the ages as a witness to Christ, down to us today. They encourage us to persevere in our “race” of faith and life.

Come to hear their witness; be encouraged and inspired by the Living Word. Invite others. Supper will be served before the services by our youth. A puppet show will be offered for the younger children during the service. Lent is here, prepare for the coming of the Resurrection!

A blessed Lent as you too witness to this hope that is ours in our Crucified and Risen Lord.

Our February meeting was held at 2:00 pm on the 15th. Dorothy Eklund gave devotions based on 2 Timothy 3:10-17.

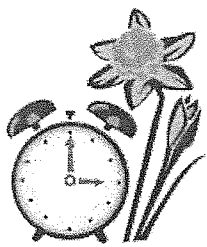

LIBRARY NEWS

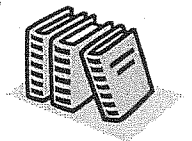
Our church library offers a variety of reading. The following is a summary of a few of the books that you might find interesting.

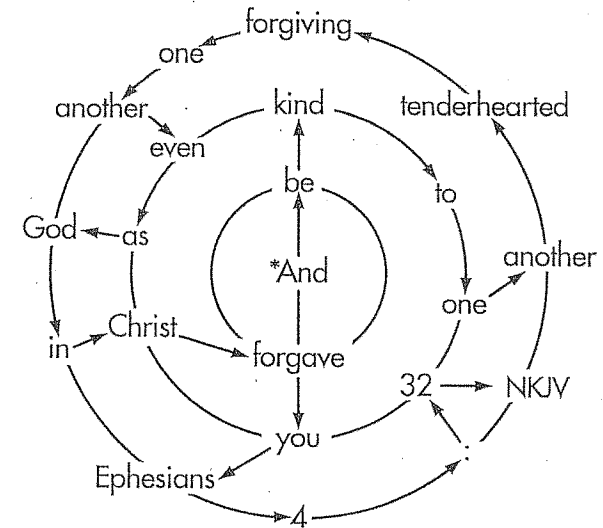


WHY FORGIVE?






This Bible verse teaches an important lesson about how we should treat others — and why.

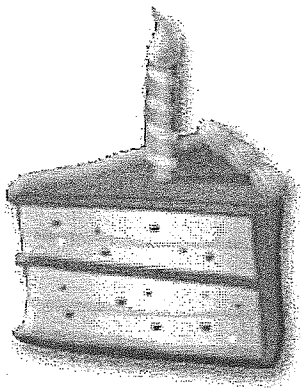

Out Like a Lamb

Forgiveness BRACELET

Jesus died on the cross to forgive our sins, and he tells us to forgive other people, too. Make and wear this craft as a reminder that you are forgiven — and should be forgiving.

What you need:

- Clear plastic bottle (about 16 oz.)
- An adult to help
- Scissors
- Construction paper
- Permanent black marker
- Glue or clear tape
- Thin ribbon or yarn
- Small hole punch

What you do:

1. Remove any label from the bottle. Have an adult help you cut the bottle in half, width-wise. At the middle, cut out two identical half-inch-wide strips.
2. Cut out paper the same size as the plastic strips.
3. On the paper, write "Forgive, and you will be forgiven" (Luke 6:37, NIV).
4. Place the paper between the two plastic strips.
5. Cut and glue the ribbon or yarn to run along the top and bottom of the verse, framing the words.
6. Punch a hole at each end, through all three layers.
7. Tie the bracelet to your wrist with ribbon or yarn.
